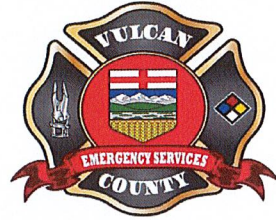

FIRE BAN IN EFFECT

March 31, 2021

Under the Authority of the Vulcan County Fire Services Bylaw # 2017-003, Vulcan County has enacted a **Fire Ban** in accordance with Sections 13.1 and 13.2 of the Fire Services bylaw on all open fires in the County with the following exceptions:

- Gas or Propane Fire pits in approved fire rings

All active Fire Permits are cancelled. No new Fire Permits or Fireworks Permits will be issued until further notice.

- When a fire ban is in effect, any person who contravenes the fire ban may be subject to the fines as set by the Province of Alberta and for the fees associated with a fire department response.

Due to the dry conditions we ask everyone to be extremely careful in the outdoors. We thank you in advance for your co-operation and assistance during this ban.
