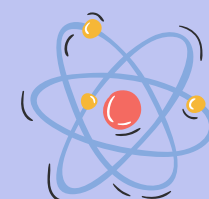

The Kids Club- Drop In Space is OPEN on Saturdays for kids 7-12 years. There are crafts, games, books and more. Drop In is from 9-11:30am

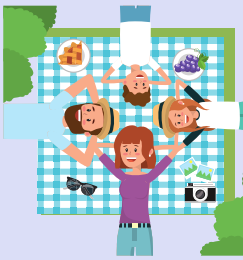
