



FIRE ADVISORY IN EFFECT

August 31, 2023

Under the Authority of the Vulcan County Fire Services Bylaw # 2023-010, Vulcan County has **CANCELLED** the Fire Restriction and **ENACTED A FIRE ADVISORY** in accordance with Sections 13.1 and 13.2 of the Fire Services bylaw.

Vulcan County has received enough moisture to move to an Advisory. We will continue to monitor moisture levels and fire risk throughout the County, and may update the status as needed. Fire permits are being issued, but may be cancelled at any time with little to no notice. If conditions change, the County may impose a Fire Ban or Restriction at any time. If a Fire Ban or Restriction is imposed, you must immediately and fully extinguish your fire.

Fire Permits will be reviewed Monday – Friday between 8am and 430pm. Permits requested on the weekend or holidays will not be reviewed until the next business day.

This Fire Advisory is in effect until further notice.

Declaration for Cancellation of Fire Restriction

August 31, 2023

Due to an increased demand for fire permits and the predicted precipitation to come over the weekend, and under the authority of Vulcan County Fire Service Bylaw #2023-010, Part 13, Vulcan County hereby issues cancellation of a Fire Restriction that was enacted on August 21, 2023. Vulcan County will continue to monitor moisture levels and may implement a Fire Restriction or Ban with little to no notice. Please watch the Vulcan County website and Alberta Fire Bans.ca for changes in the fire status. Should a Restriction or Ban be put in place, you must immediately and fully extinguish your fire.

Fire Permits will be reviewed Monday – Friday between 8am and 430pm. Permits requested on the weekend or holidays will not be reviewed until the next business day.
